

2019 Toowoomba Swap Meet information

There are a lot of changes so please read carefully.

Our move to online bookings for 2019 was delayed because of issues with the bank in establishing a facility to accept credit card payments for the swap site sales. This has not yet been resolved, but it is not far away. Because we were waiting for this to be fixed, we could not take bookings or allow you to rebook for 2020. We apologise for the delays.

Don't worry, you will be given until 28 February 2019 to rebook your sites for 2020. The cut off of 11 am on the Sunday of the swap will no longer apply. Rest assured that if you do not have internet access, you will be able to rebook during the swap, but if you have internet access you can rebook at home and not have to queue. Once the new reservation deadline of 28.02.19 has passed, any sites not paid for will then be open for anyone else to book.

This mail out contains your 2019 swap tax invoice/statement and the new bar coded online ticket which you will need to present for scanning at the gate to get in. Note that there will be no need for a mail out in future years.

For this year, no refunds for cancelled site/s will be issued after 16 January 2019. If you cancel your site booking we will no longer allow the site/s booked to be rolled over for the next year. You will lose that site/s.

The move to online ticketing means that there will no longer need to be a \$30 per site replacement fee for lost tickets.

If we have to print and post tickets rather than send them via email (where you print at home or show it on your smart phone), there will be a \$3 surcharge for printing, mailing & handling.

Site tickets no longer need to be affixed to your windscreen, instead the printed bar coded ticket enclosed with this mail out or the ticket on your smart phone will be scanned as you enter through the gate.

Site tickets still entitle one vehicle per site, and up to two people (driver plus a passenger), plus two nights camping. If you have extra passengers, the 2 day admission fee for the extra people will need to be paid upon entry.

Public Liability Insurance: Darling Downs Veteran & Vintage Motor Club Inc. (DDVVMC Inc.) Public Liability Insurance does not provide cover to swap site holders and DDVVMC Inc. accepts no liability for acts of negligence on a site holder's swap site. It is the responsibility of swap site holders to arrange their own Public Liability Insurance cover.

Site holders are responsible for their own security. Everything must be inside your swap site boundary.

Multi site holders are responsible to pass, post or email one of their tickets to the driver of vehicles occupying each of their sites. No Ticket No Entry.

Arm band pass outs will be made available to site holders leaving the swap and intending to return.

A \$50 refundable deposit is required at the gate for non-site holder's vehicles only delivering items to a site. The deposit will be returned on departure, provided the vehicle leaves the grounds within one hour.

Emergency Services and Workplace Health & Safety require that no vehicles are to be parked on any road or walkway at any time.

No driving of vehicles, riding of push bikes or motor cycles is allowed during the swap meet.

Parts pickup from sites is available all weekend, and goods are delivered to a collection area at "Gate 5" outside the showgrounds (Harvey Road).

The price of swap sites for the 2020 swap will be released when site sales for 2020 swap sites are opened.

DISPLAY VEHICLES ENTRY ON SATURDAY ONLY. Must be driven in, no trailers or swapping on car site.
NO DOGS ALLOWED INSIDE SHOWGROUNDS.
